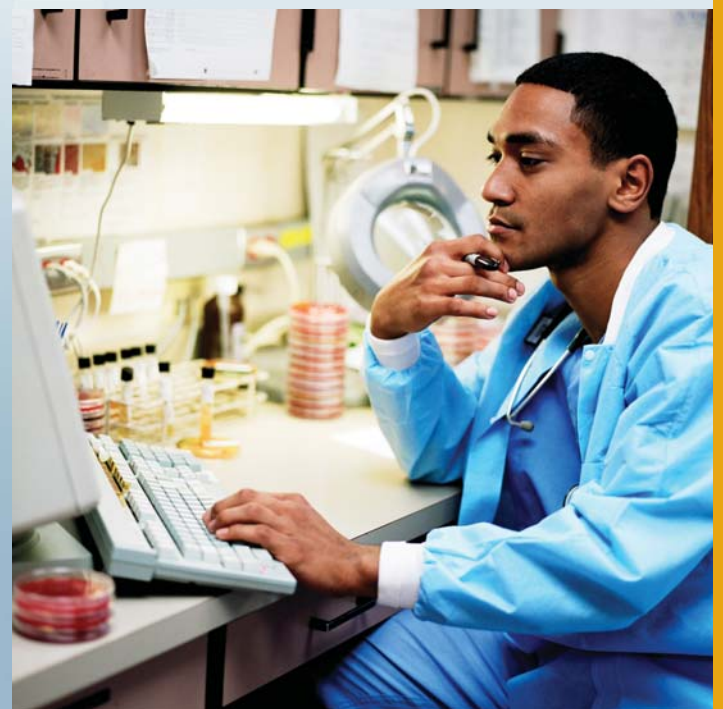
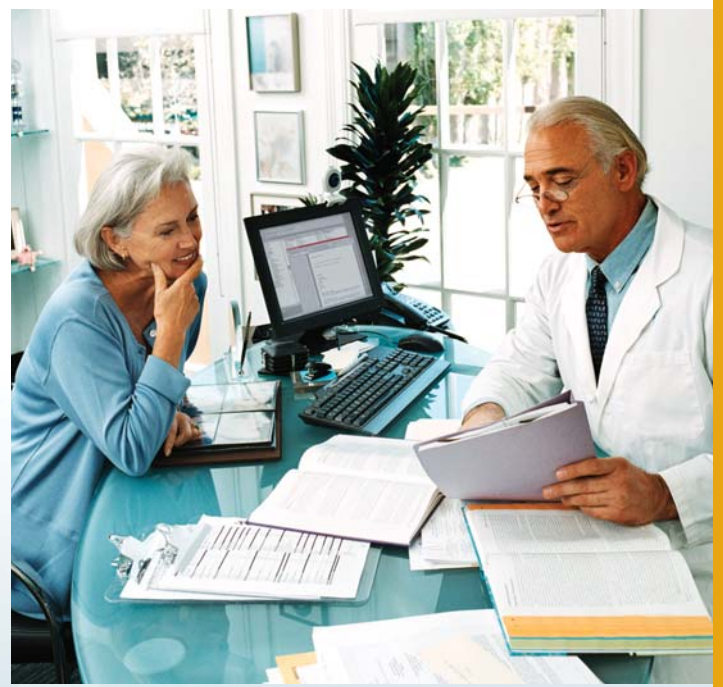
Alberta Netcare is the province's electronic health record, a secure way for physicians and authorized health care professionals to quickly access key patient information and reduce treatment delays. It is not your complete medical history.

Alberta Netcare will include information such as prescription, allergy, and lab test results from the health system, not just your own health provider. This information will be received by your provider faster than before. It will help them better assess what tests are required, give you a diagnosis based on information from more of the health system, and better coordinate your care with other providers.

Alberta Netcare Electronic Health Record is a highly secure system. Only authorized health professionals can use the system. Under the *Health Information Act*, health providers can access the minimum amount of information necessary to treat you. All accesses are logged and subject to audits.
