

WHY DO THE SCREENS LOOK DIFFERENT?

New Look for Alberta Netcare Portal

With the February 27, 2014, Alberta Netcare release, there will be a few changes to the way Alberta Netcare Portal looks.

FORMATTING CHANGES

1. The **framework** is now gray instead of blue. The **menu bar** now uses arrows to represent sub menus.
2. There are new shortcut icons for **Home Page**, **My Details** and **Help**.
3. There are new shortcut icons for **choosing a patient from the list**, **displaying the next patient** or **displaying the previous patient from that list**.
4. The **Worklist** icon has changed and has moved to a new location.

CHANGE TO DATE FORMAT IN CLINICAL DOCUMENT VIEWER

In the Clinical Document Viewer, the dates will be shown using a different format:

- If the report is less than 24 hours old, it will display the Hour/Minute and name of report. **ex: 07:55 Troponin**
- If the report is more than 24 hours old, but less than 7 days, it will display Day/Hour/Minute and name of report. **ex: Thu 12:56 Urea**
- If the report is more than 7 days old, it will display the Date and Name of report. **ex: 03-May-13 Urine Macroscopic**. This is the same format as displayed previously.

CHANGES TO PATIENT SEARCH

1. There is a new location for the *Last Name, First Name, and Middle Name/Initial* fields.
2. The *Date of Birth* has been updated; there are now separate fields for Day, Month and Year.
3. There is a new location for your *favourite searches*.

3. The *Rename* and *Print* functions have been updated to links.

NEW FUNCTIONALITY: TRANSCRIBED REPORT HISTORY NOW AVAILABLE FOR CALGARY

Using *Report History* you may now compare an updated transcribed report with earlier versions:

1. Click *Show Version* to display the desired version of the report.
