

This quick reference provides instructions for navigating the Cumulative Results functionality in Alberta Netcare Portal (ANP).

NOTE

The default cumulative results period is 180 days. You can change the default cumulative results period in "My Details." For instructions consult the quick reference [How to Customize User Preferences](#).

Accessing Cumulative Results

- 1 Access the Clinical Document Viewer (CDV) and select the desired clinical document.
- 2 Click **View Cumulative Results** at the top of the page. Cumulative results are displayed by test date.

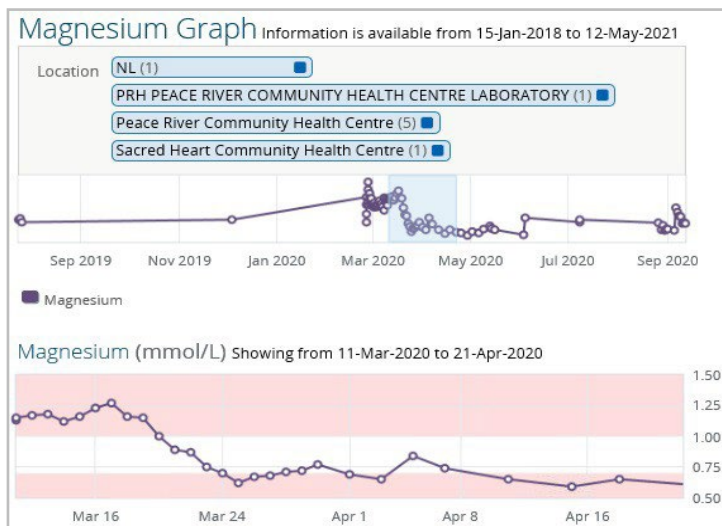

- a Click **Print** to print the cumulative result.
- b Click **Send** to email the result to another ANP user. The recipient requires the appropriate Alberta Netcare user role to view the document.
- c Click **Data Inquiry** to report suspected data issues. An email with the record you are viewing will be sent to the Person Identity Management (PIM) team.
- d Click **Dock** to open the document in a separate docked windowlet. This functionality enables you to view and compare multiple lab results or other documents side-by-side.

Graphing Cumulative Results

- 1 To view the cumulative results on a graph, select the check boxes beside the test or click the **Select All** check box, then click **Graph**.
- 2 To zoom into a date range, click and drag to highlight the desired date range. The selected range will display in the graphs below.



Can I still view a cumulative result if the “?” is tagged to the selected test?

A mismatch in a patient's date of birth and/or gender between the Lab Results Data System and the Alberta Health Services (AHS) Client Registry is called a “demographic mismatch,” and is identified by the **?** icon next to the clinical document. Abnormal results with a question mark icon will not be displayed in a graph generated from a cumulative view.
