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Description:	History and Physical notes from Connect Care are now available
Detail:	On January 20, 2020, the History and Physical note was stopped as a larger piece of work to better limit the amount of documentation coming from Connect Care to Netcare.
	Feedback from the Netcare user community regarding the clinical value of History and Physical notes has resulted in the History and Physical note being added back on to the list of documentation sent from Connect Care to Netcare.

2. Relocation of Echo Results and ECG Folder Name Change			
Description:	Echo results are being rearranged to provide a consistent location for reports, the ECG/Echocardiogram (MAZ) folder will be renamed to reflect the change.		
Detail:	Echo reports which previously displayed in the ECG/Echocardiogram (MAZ) folder have been moved to the Diagnostic Imaging folder. These reports will no longer be available in the ECG/Echocardiogram (MAZ) folder. *Note: The ECG/Echocardiogram (MAZ) folder will return to its original name ECG/Electrodiagnostics.		



3. Updated ED Treatment Plans			
Description:	This change affects modified ED Treatment Plans that were created in SCM over 12 months ago. ED Treatment Plans created less than 12 months ago will not be affected by this change.		
Detail:	A previous change in SCM created an issue where modified ED Treatment Plans (created over 12 months ago) in SCM, were not received by Netcare.		
	Once this change is complete, all updates to ED Treatment Plans will be reflected in both SCM and Netcare in order to provide clinicians with accurate clinical information.		
	*Note: Existing ED Treatment Plans that were previously reviewed by a physician in Netcare will now appear bold and unread in the CDV Tree.
