








2. Launch Connect Care Provider Portal (CCPP) from Netcare


Description:

Netcare users can now access Connect Care Provider Portal from Netcare.


Details:

Users with the following Netcare Access roles can now open into a patient's context in CCPP.

- Admin 1-3
- Clinical 1, 2, 4, 8, 9
- Pharmacy 2, 5



- When the new tab is clicked, the user will be prompted to select the appropriate Connect Care department.
- Once the department is selected, if the Netcare patient has a valid Uli, then
 a new browser tab will open and the user will automatically be signed into
 CCPP into the same patient's context.
- If the current patient does not have a valid ULI, the user will see the following message and CCPP will not open.

*Note: Users must have active accounts for both Netcare and CCPP.
