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## Alberta Netcare Portal Enhancements

### 1. New COVID-19 Treatment Folder

**Description:** New Netcare folder contains Monoclonal Antibody (mAb) treatment reports for COVID-19.

**Details:** Clinicians will now have access to COVID-19 mAb treatment reports through a new Netcare folder:

- Called "COVID-19 Treatment"
- Located below the BPMH form on the CDV Tree
- Displayed on the CDV Tree only when it contains reports

**\*Note:** Patients treated with Monoclonal Antibody (mAb) treatments (Sotrovimab) need to wait 90 days prior to receiving a COVID-19 vaccination.

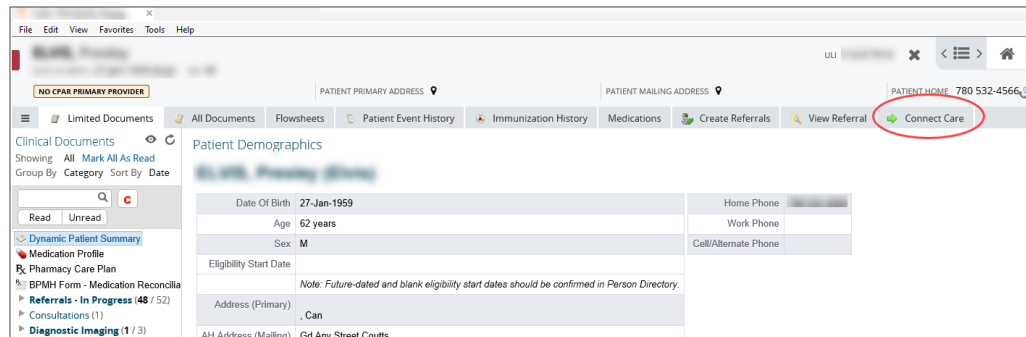

## 2. Launch Connect Care Provider Portal (CCPP) from Netcare

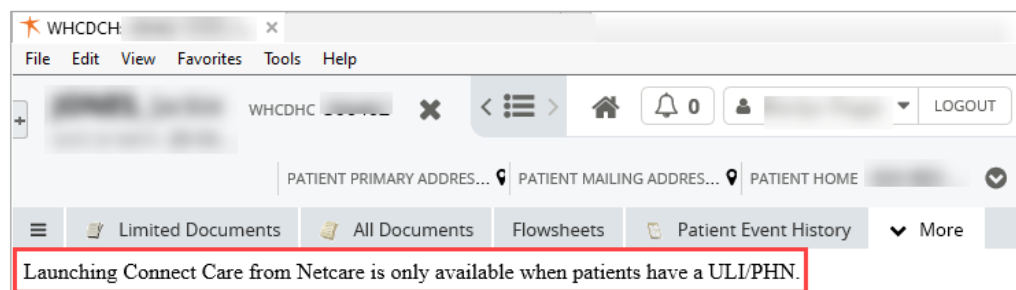
**Description:** Netcare users can now access Connect Care Provider Portal from Netcare.

**Details:** Users with the following Netcare Access roles can now open into a patient's context in CCPP.

- Admin 1-3
- Clinical 1, 2, 4, 8, 9
- Pharmacy 2, 5



- When the new tab is clicked, the user will be prompted to select the appropriate Connect Care department.
- Once the department is selected, if the Netcare patient has a valid ULI, then a new browser tab will open and the user will automatically be signed into CCPP into the same patient's context.
- If the current patient does not have a valid ULI, the user will see the following message and CCPP will not open.
