

This document provides instructions on how to view Operative Reports in Alberta Netcare Portal (ANP).

Community Information Integration (CII) is a system that transfers select patient information between community Electronic Medical Records (EMRs) and other members of the patient's care team through Alberta Netcare. The Central Patient Attachment Registry (CPAR) is a provincial system that captures the confirmed relationship of a primary provider and their paneled patients.

CII continues making the data collected in community clinics available to authorized healthcare providers through ANP. To date, consult letters and information about patient visits to contribute are being uploaded from CII/CPAR enabled clinics.

The latest data type, Operative Reports, will allow community-based specialist clinics to submit information on operative procedures performed by specialists within CII/CPAR enabled clinics.

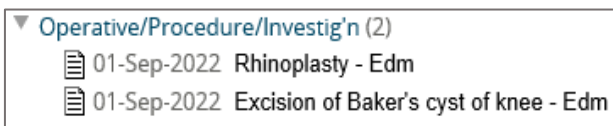
Viewing an Operative Report

This document provides instructions on how to view an Operative Report in ANP.

The Operative reports provide information on surgeries performed on a patient such as preoperative and postoperative diagnosis, description of the surgical procedure, and any findings or complications encountered during the surgery.

To view an Operative Report:

- 1 Search for your patient and open their Electronic Health Record (EHR).
- 2 In the Clinical Document Viewer (CDV) Tree, select the "**Operative/Procedure/Investig'n**" folder for a list of available operative reports.

- 3 Click on the desired Operative Report to view it in the Dynamic Patient Summary.
