

This quick reference provides instructions for viewing the COVID-19 Treatment folder in Alberta Netcare Portal (ANP).

The COVID-19 Treatment folder for Monoclonal Antibody (mAb) treatments is now available in ANP.

**NOTE** Patients given Monoclonal Antibody (mAb) treatments (a.k.a., “sotrovimab”) must wait **90 days** before receiving their COVID-19 vaccination.

- The COVID-19 treatment folder is only displayed in the Clinical Document Viewer (CDV) (below “BPMH Form”) if a patient has received Monoclonal Antibody (mAb) treatments (a.k.a., “sotrovimab”).
- COVID-19 treatment will also trigger the creation of an encounter in the Patient Event History functionality.
