



How to Add a Person to PD

This quick reference provides instructions for adding a person to Person Directory (PD).

Four out of the five registration types are covered. Adding a newborn is covered in the quick reference "Registering/ Updating a Newborn."

Authorized Permission Levels

The following Alberta Netcare permission levels can add a person in PD:

- Admin 1
- Admin 2
- Clinical 8
- Clinical 10

Registration Types

There are five registration types in PD.



- Newborn (born in Alberta, 28 days or under) Consult the quick reference "Registering/ Updating a Newborn."
- Visitor to Alberta (e.g., out of province or out of country).
- 3 Federally insured (for Canadian forces, federal inmates, federally insured refugees).
- 4 Alberta resident (e.g., new resident or not previous registered).
- 5 Dependent child (of already registered parent, e.g., adopted).

Search First/Duplicate Checking



Any person who has had contact with the Primary & Preventative Health Services (PPHS) system will have a Unique Lifetime Identifier (ULI) or a Personal Health Number (PHN).

1 Log into Alberta Netcare Portal (ANP), access PD and search for the individual by completing as many of the search criteria as possible to prevent duplicates. Click Search.

Click the name of the applicable individual. If the search returns no results, click **Add Person**.

Add Person by Registration Type

Varying demographic data fields will appear based on the selected registration type.

VISITOR TO ALBERTA

Preferred Name: First and last name

Additional Information

- Gender,
- Date and province of birth

NOTE Date of birth is mandatory if the person is visiting Alberta from within Canada.

Phone Number

- Usage (residential, personal, or business),

Visiting from within Canada

- Select Out of Province ID Type and enter ID number
- or check Out of Province ID not provided

Visiting from Outside Canada

Select country of origin and enter date of entry into Canada

FEDERALLY INSURED



Federally insured persons include members of the Canadian Forces, inmates in a federal penitentiary and federally insured refugees.

Preferred Name: First and last name

- Gender
- Date and province of birth (choose outside AB or inside AB)
- Choose alternate ID type (Canadian Forces Number or Veterans Affairs Canada Number) and enter Alternate ID number.

RESIDENT OF ALBERTA

Registration Date: Defaults to current date

- Country of origin
- Alberta entry date
- Canada entry date
- Alternate ID type and number, if applicable

Residential Address: Choose Civic Mailing Address or Delivery Installation Address.

- Usage (residential, personal, or business.)
- Type (telephone, cellular phone, fax, beeper, or teletype)
- Phone number OR international phone

Start date

DEPENDENT CHILD (OF ALREADY REGISTERED PARENT)

This registration type is used to add a dependent child for a person with Alberta Health Care Insurance Plan (AHCIP) eligibility.



This function cannot be used if the child is older than 16 years.

Parent/Guardian Information: Enter PHN/ULI of the parent or guardian. If the PHN/ULI is not available, use the PHN/ULI search function.

Dependent Child Information:

- Registration date defaults to today
- Dependent Reason (adopted, custody, guardianship, or parent of)
- Enter date placed in care

Preferred Name:

First, last and middle name. Enter suffix if applicable

Person Details:

- Gender,
- Date and province of birth
- Province/state of origin
- Country of origin,
- Alberta entry date
- Canada entry date
- Out-of-province ID type and out-of-province ID
