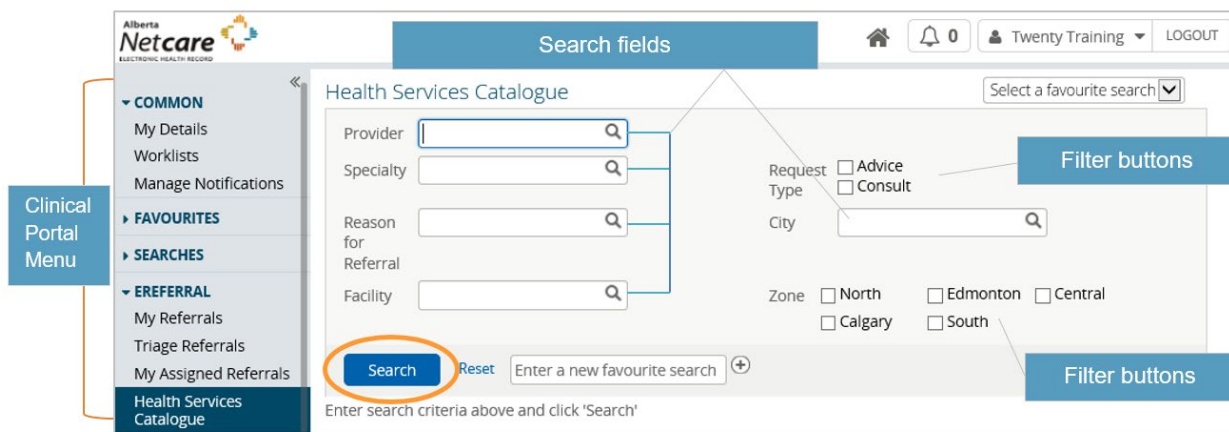


The **Health Services Catalogue** (HSC) is a repository of eReferral information that includes reasons for referral, referral requirements, specialty names, facilities, clinical pathways, providers and/or approximate wait times. It is accessible through the **Clinical Portal Menu** as per the example below or when creating an Advice and/or Consult Request.

Search Information Lookup

The HSC allows you to search for information about a *Provider, Specialty, Reason for Referral* or *Facility* within Alberta. You can also filter your search results by *Request Type, City* or *Zone*.

NOTE: The Zone filter defaults to the Preferred Zones pre-selected in **My Details**.



- 1 Click on **Health Services Catalogue** located in the **Clinical Portal Menu** on the left-side of your screen.
- 2 Enter information into the fields and then click **Search**. The search returns results from the HSC based on your input.

- Click on the underlined text in the search results list to access a pop-up page that displays further information on the *Reason for Referral*, *Specialty*, or *Provider*. An example of a specialty pop-up information page is displayed below.

Reason for Referral	Advice
Hematuria microscopic (greater than 3 rbc/hpf)	Advice
Kidney stone chronic (non-obstructing)	Advice
Nephrology issue	Advice
Proteinuria	Advice
Acute nephrotic syndrome	Consult
Hereditary kidney disease	Consult
Hypertension refractory to treatment with 4 or more antihypertensive agents	Consult
Persistent albuminuria (ACR > 60 mg/mmol) - confirmed on repeat testing (2 out of 3 samples) within 2-4 weeks	Consult
Persistent electrolyte abnormalities	Consult
Persistent hematuria - confirmed on repeat testing (2 out of 3 samples) within 2-4 weeks	Consult

Search the HSC when Creating and Advice or Consult Request

When creating a request, you can browse the HSC to select a *Reason for Referral* through a pop-up search. Further define your search by *Provider*, *Specialty*, *Reason for Referral*, *Facility* and/or *City*.
